

## WHY FOCUS ON FLUENCY... AND WHY SO EARLY?

#### The research tells us that

- Reading fluency is a key predictor of school outcomes.
- Students who fall behind in reading fluency are rarely able to catch up.
- Fluency facilitates comprehension the end goal of all reading.
- 5-17% of your PreK-2 students are at risk for dyslexia and its devastating consequences. The most common learning disability, dyslexia impairs reading fluency.
- English language learners are often at risk for reading problems and they can benefit from instruction in fluency.
- Children from low income households are at greater risk of reading failure. Fluency and comprehension growth are slower processes for them as compared to their more affluent peers.



In many schools there are high percentages of children not reaching proficiency in Tier 1. The *Fluency Builders* program is designed to reverse this trend by *optimizing* the *PreK-2 window*.



## Prevention Options

- Use as a preventative PreK-2 Tier 1 supplement for all students. Start with the universal PreK-2 *Fluency Builders Dyslexia Screener* to identify those at risk along with their unique deficit profile. Differentiate instruction based on the Screener results to minimize the number of students requiring intervention.
- Or use as a PreK-2 Tier 3 intervention for those students identified to be at risk for reading failure. Start with the universal PreK-2 *Fluency Builders Dyslexia Screener* to identify these students along with their unique deficit profile for a targeted intervention.

The evidence-based instructional model is designed to reduce the number of students requiring intervention by using it as a Tier 1 supplement in PreK-2. Although all students can benefit from the *Fluency Builders* PreventionIntervention program, it has been specifically designed for students at risk, such as students with dyslexia, English language learners, and students from low income households.

Phonological and phonemic awareness, phonics, high frequency words, spelling, and handwriting instruction are fully integrated into the program, providing significant cost savings over purchasing these components separately. 
#### Intervention




#### **PreK-2 Reading Failure Prevention**


